CASE STUDY

New West End Company

A review of deliveries to our office led us to:

- Consolidate our stationary and grocery suppliers
- Provide staff with information on redirecting personal deliveries
- Adopt a preferred supplier for outgoing deliveries who uses no-emission cycle courier

We expect this to reduce vehicle movements from our office by up to a third, and to cut emissions from remaining deliveries by using low-emission suppliers.
